Summer staff position as Camp Photographer / Videographer in an outdoor setting. The program is designed to work with Learning Disabled and Attention Deficit Hyperactive Disorder students ranging from 8-25 years of age.

Responsibilities include: The Camp Photographer / Videographer is responsible for capturing daily life at camp and making images and video available to parents through the online parent portal and social media. Images and video will also be used for marketing and promotional purposes. The Camp Photographer / Videographer is responsible for covering a variety of courses & groups within a three hour radius in western North Carolina or in Wyoming. The Camp Photographer / Videographer is a contract summer staff position and will require candidates to participate in a two week staff training and live at basecamp for the full summer season (roughly 10 weeks).

The Camp Photographer / Videographer will travel with groups of 7-8 campers (with 2 staff per group), for up to 24 hours a day, and up to 6 days a week. Camp activities may include backpacking, rock climbing, whitewater rafting, caving, mountain biking, horseback riding, high and low ropes courses, canoeing, fishing, sea kayaking, funyaking, archery, hatchet throwing, tubing, boating, llama trekking, primitive skills, and paintball.

Requirements for the position include: Must be at least 21 years of age (some exceptions will be considered); experience in design, art, or media related field preferred. 2+ Years of Photography / Videography Experience. This position does require regional travel. Applicants must have reliable transportation. Must submit a portfolio to be considered for the position.
